Cross off each box that you are able to complete while you are out of school. See how many you can do!

Sing 2 songs you learned in class for a family member at home.	Try one of our dances from class with a sibling or stuffed animal. Is it harder or easier than in class?	Describe to someone at your house how you sing an echo song.	Read a book and think of a song that could go with it.	Create a song only using things you find in your kitchen.
Sit quietly for 3 minutes and write down all the sounds you hear.	Write a song that has ABA form. Make sure the A sections are the same.	Listen to your favorite song on YouTube.	Draw curvy, zigzag, or straight lines on a piece of paper and Try to sing them like an owl, a wolf, or a cow.	Make up a song about your favorite food to the tune of song we learned in class.
Make up a B section to a nursery rhyme using body percussion.	Pretend you are a seed and grow into a plant with an interesting shape. Can you grow slowly? Quickly?	Create new movements to one of our songs from class.	Make up new words to a rhyme that you know.	Write down 5 things that would be very different if they didn't have music with them.
Spend 5 minutes playing in silence. No cheating! Is it hard or easy to be silent?	Imagine a world without music. Write down 3 things that would be worse.	Draw a picture of an instrument you would like to learn to play.	Call a friend or family member and sing them a song we learned in class.	Invent a new instrument. Draw a picture of it and describe how it works.
